**Friday 6th May: Pollok Country Park**

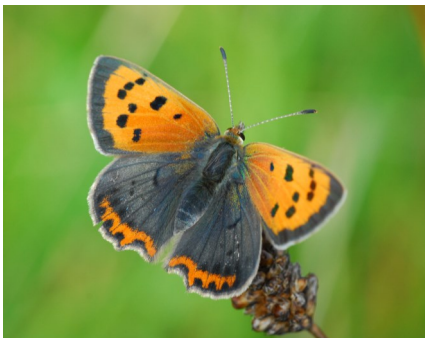
**Saturday 7th May: Tollcross Park**
